## Contractor's Qualification Statement for the Historic Properties Repair Program

**Introduction.** The Historic Properties Repair Program (HPRP) is an initiative funded by the City of Philadelphia and administered by the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia. HPRP assists low- and moderate-income homeowners with grants for exterior repairs to their homes so that the historic character of their neighborhoods can be maintained. HPRP will make grants to owners of historic residences in amounts that equal the difference between basic exterior "remodeling" projects and restoration work of a higher standard, quality, and historical accuracy.

HPRP will maintain a list of pre-qualified contractors from which homeowners can contract to undertake these grant-funded projects. The program encourages small and minority-owned businesses to apply for qualification. Contractors to be considered for inclusion on the pre-qualification list are required to complete the information below and return this form and any attachments to:

**Minimum qualifications for contractor:** Pre-qualified contractors must document adequate experience with and knowledge of the proper treatment and restoration of historic structures and their materials. Familiarity and experience with the procedures and restoration standards of the Philadelphia Historical Commission is highly desirable. The trades of pre-qualified contractors may include, but are not limited to: general contractors, masons, carpenters, roofers, painters and decorative finishers, metalworkers, plasterers, tile setters, glaziers, and suppliers of materials, especially those that are historically authentic.
