In the first limited-edition print, entitled *Now Preserve*, Philadelphia-based artist Jane Irish subtly juxtaposes decorative

interior architectural motifs from the Boyd Theater with messages of political advocacy.

Jane Irish has had solo exhibitions at Locks Gallery, Philadelphia, and the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts (PAFA), and has been awarded grants from the Independence Foundation, Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, and National Endowment for the Arts, among others. Her work can be found in public collections, including those of PAFA and the Philadelphia Museum of Art.
